

Carbon Labelling

To guide you to better food choices for our planet, Manchester Central have partnered with Klimato to present carbon labels on all our menus. Food accounts for almost one third of global emissions. By changing our diets to eating food with a lower carbon footprint, we contribute to reducing emissions which is essential in halting climate change.

Who are Klimato?

Klimato is a sustainability partner for any business with a F&B offering to calculate, report and reduce the carbon emissions from food and beverage. So far the solution is used by over 150 companies in more than 15 markets. During 2022, over 10 million meals were reported with Klimato and the average emission reduction per meal was 23%.

What do the Labels mean?

The Klimato carbon label indicates whether a dish has a Low, Medium or High carbon footprint. The thresholds are based on targets set forth by the Paris Agreement.

How is the carbon footprint of food calculated?

Klimato uses climate data from lifecycle assessments to calculate the carbon footprint of each meal. The carbon footprint of a meal is the total amount of greenhouse gas emissions (CO2e) that stem from the ingredients through each production stage.
